RE: 2024 Board Election Results Report

Dear Ms. Dunn,

At the request of the Bristol Bay Regional Seafood Development Association (BBRSDA), Cashion, Gilmore & Lindemuth (CGL) is serving as the Inspector of Elections for BBRSDA's 2024 Board of Directors Election (Election) and has attached a report of election results. This year's election did not utilize ranked-choice voting because there was no open-residency board seat up for election this year.

On April 10, 2024, CGL retrieved results from electronic ballots cast on the ElectionBuddy platform. Per BBRSDA's vote process, the electronic vote file contains anonymized vote data for each ballot cast in the Election on the ElectionBuddy platform. Paper ballots received by CGL through April 9, 2024, were shuffled, opened, assigned a ballot number, tallied, and added to the electronic vote totals. CGL then audited the combined vote file to ensure that 1) no permit had submitted multiple ballots, 2) no voter access keys were accessed without verified permission from the permit holder, and 3) paper ballot vote tallies were accurate. CGL did not include results from ballots received by CGL after April 9, 2024 (none have been received as of the date of this report), and one paper ballot was counted even though no official ballot appears to have been sent to that voter, because the voter's intent was clear for both races.

CGL then used the combined vote file to tally a winner for Seat B and Seat E. CGL determined that Peter Andrew won Seat B, and Doug Elwell won Seat E.

CGL attests that the electronic ballot results were copied directly from the ElectionBuddy platform, and that all of the properly-cast paper ballots were accurately added to create a combined, anonymized vote file. CGL attests that all of the votes were tallied and judged for eligibility in accordance with policies and procedures provided by BBRSDA. CGL attests that paper ballots received by mail did not leave the CGL office and were kept in a secure location. CGL attests that it will retain Election materials for a period of no less than three years.


CGL has provided BBRSDA with a report of election results.

**Summary of 2024 Board of Director Election Results**

<b>Board Seat</b>	<b>Winning Candidate</b>
Seat B – Alaska Resident	Peter Andrew
Seat E – Non-Alaska Residency	Doug Elwell

A total of 412 ballots were validly cast in the 2024 BBRSDA Board of Directors Election. This is up approximately 58% from the total number of ballots cast (260) in the 2023 election. A total of 373 electronic ballots and 39 paper ballots were validly cast in 2024 election.

Seat B was won by Peter Andrew, who received 244 (59.2%) of the eligible votes cast for that seat. Seat E was won by Doug Elwell, who received 158 (38.3%) of the eligible votes cast for that seat. These individuals will be seated on the BBRSDA Board of Directors for their terms at the next board meeting, assuming seats currently held by Peter Andrew (Seat B) and Matt Dewitte (Seat E).
